

New MRI CME Requirement Policy

(Effective Immediately)

All ARMRICT Certified MRI Technologists are required to renew their certification for the next three-year period and **sign a *Statement of Completion of a total of twenty-four (24) CME credits in **MRI Technology** as awarded by the AHRA, ACCME , AMA, ASRT or other qualified CME granting organization. The Renewal Form will contain the MRI CME Statement.

Sample Statement:

*MRI Continuing Medical Education Statement:

I certify that I have completed a total of **24 MRI CME Credits** some time in **2021, 2022, or 2023** and have them in my possession & available to present for unannounced Site-Visits by CMS, ACR, or other MRI Accrediting Organizations, and audits by the ARMRICT.

Important: an ARMRICT MRI Technologist who cannot document completion of the required CME credits upon demand is subject to immediate revocation of their certification.


Do not send Transcripts/Certificates to ARMRICT unless audited.
